Are you not authorised for OSIRIS Teacher? Please contact the director or coordinator of your education? He/she has contact with the project leader about authorization of the teachers and examiners.

To use OSIRIS Teacher the best browsers to use are Firefox or Chrome.

For OSIRIS Teacher the following roles are designed for use of result registration:

ROLE: TUTOR	ROLE: TEACHER	ROLE: EXAMINER

After teachers have registered the results the examiner has to finalise the registration process, by signing electronically for approval, after which the results have the status 'definite', and will be visible for the students.

Access to OSIRIS Teacher result registration

Via the [webapps](#) – employee you can choose the application OSIRIS Teacher/Tutor.

Approve results by electronically signing

There are two ways to approve/sign the results:

1. On the home screen of OSIRIS Teacher you'll find a red link to the tests waiting for you approval.
Select the link 'sign'.
Use your m-number and password to sign the results. You can check them in advance of course.
After signing a status report will appear in which you can see if signing was successful.
By signing electronically for approval, after which the results have the status 'definite' and will be visible for the students.
2. Click in OSIRIS on the button 'Sign Results'.
Select the test(s) you want to approve/sign.
Click 'sign electronically'
Use your m-number and password to sign the results. You can check them in advance of course.
After signing a status report will appear in which you can see if signing was successful.
By signing electronically for approval, after which the results have the status 'definite', and will be visible for the students.
3. After finishing registration, close OSIRIS Teacher.
