


**Required information by NVAO and WHW?**

**• Standaard 3:**  
“De opleiding beschikt over een *adeqaat systeem van toetsing en toont aan dat de beoogde eindkwalificaties worden gerealiseerd.*”

**Two key points:**

- Adequate assessment/test system (criteria: valid, reliable and transparent)
- Meet final Final qualifications

**Toelichting:**  
“Het gerealiseerde niveau blijkt uit de tussentijdse en afsluitende *toetsen*, de *afstudeerwerken* en de wijze waarop afgestudeerden *in de praktijk* of in een vervolgopleiding *functioneren*. De toetsen en de beoordeling zijn *valide, betrouwbaar* en voor studenten *inzichtelijk*”

**Required Info by Law?**

**Information to be reviewed/improved:**

- a) Program Intended Learning Outcomes (PILOs)
- b) “contents and structure of the programme” ⇔ (how are PILOs covered by ILOs of modules/courses)
- c) Realized end-level (Tests, reports, Theses)
- d) Proper assessments: valid, reliable & transparent (course files analysis of test outcomes)
- e) Examiners list with BKE/BKO/SKE info
- f) Improve Systematically: PDCA: Plan Do Check Act

- c. het **gerealiseerde eindniveau**, gelet op hetgeen internationaal gewenst en gangbaar is,
- d. de **deugdelijkheid van beoordeling, toetsing en examining** van de studenten,
- e. de **kwaliteit en kwantiteit van het ingezette personeel** alsmede het personeelsbeleid dat van invloed is op de kwaliteit van de opleiding,
- f. de **opleidingspecifieke voorzieningen** alsmede de instellingsbrede voorzieningen die van invloed zijn op de kwaliteit van de opleiding daaronder mede begrepen voldoende studiebegeleiding en voorzieningen die de toegankelijkheid en studiebaarheid voor studenten met een functiebeperking bevorderen, en
