
Enhancing the Role of the Examination Board in Academic Assessment

For quality safeguarding, we need,

- Continuous Monitoring and Evaluation:
- Stakeholder Engagement
- Adaptive Assessment Strategies
- Clear Communication

Operationalization guide for PM&EB:

- 1- Safeguarding end qualifications:
- A Collaborative initiative by PM and EB to screen a module and a master's course with CELT assistance.
 - -PM leads the process, while EB advises,
- Continuous screening at the bachelor level in TCS.
 - -PM arranges reflection moments with added quality questions from EB.
- 2-Safeguarding the quality of thesis grading:
- Program Management organizes 'thesis carousels'
 - -Diverse examiners re-evaluate previous theses to maintain grading consistency.
- 3- Examiner's qualification:
- PM provides a quarterly preliminary list of examiners, specifying qualifications and nominated exams.
- EB decides on the approval or disapproval of examiners.
- EB notifies each appointed examiner with necessary information via email.

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
