	<p>Svetlana N. Khapova is Professor of Careers and Organization Studies and Scientific Director of Amsterdam Business Research Institute (ABRI) at Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam. She is Chair of the VU School of Management, and Visiting Professor at ESMT – European School of management and Technology, Berlin. She is Past Division Chair of the Careers Division of the Academy of Management. Her research concerns contemporary issues in work and careers. Khapova is a founding director of ABRI (VU) and has developed all of its doctoral education programmes related to management and organization studies. For her work she received numerous awards among which are Leadership Award from the Academy of Management, best paper and best reviewer award from Emerald, among others.</p>

Joy's research has focused, for more than 30 years, on small scale energy systems for developing countries. Gender and energy has been an important factor addressed in this research. She is a founder member of ENERGIA, the international network on Gender for whom she currently the Principal Investigator in a 5 year £4.5 million research project funded by the UK's Department for International Development (DfID) From 2009 to 2013 Dr Clancy was a technical advisor on gender and energy to the World Bank AFREA Programme. She has recently contributed to the Global Tracking Framework 2015 Report.</p>
