3 IACIS NEWS

3.1 Presidential Message

I am pleased to say that arrangements are now well in hand for the 12th IACIS-sponsored International Conferences on Surface and Colloid Science (ICSCS) meeting in Beijing next October (15-20th). First circulars (announcing the Plenary Lecturers and the titles of the various technical sessions) have been produced and are enclosed in this Newsletter, and a conference website is up and running (http://12ICSCS.yzu.edu.cn). If you wish to contact the organisers then the e-mail address to use is ICSCS@yzu.edu.cn. Prof Rong Guo, who is the President of Yangzhou University, is the chairman of the local organising committee. Both he and his personal assistant (Lily Young) have been very helpful in liaising with the Standing Committee of the IACIS Council regarding the arrangements. I visited China in March this year and Dimo Platikanov (the Immediate Past President of IACIS) visited in September, as the guests of Rong Guo, and we both met with the main conference organisers and viewed the proposed conference venue. As I mentioned in my last Newsletter messsage, the meeting will be held at the Beijing International Conference Centre (BICC), a large modern complex, conveniently located between the City Centre and the Airport. It has a large number of meeting rooms of various sizes, and will cater easily, therefore, for a multi-session scientific meeting; the largest will seat up to 2000, and will be suitable for the plenary lectures. A variety of accommodation venues nearby should be available. It looks like being a great meeting and venue, and I do hope that you will attend, and encourage others to do so also!

The main news item to announce in this message is that the 13th ICSCS, in 2009, will be held in New York, at Columbia University.

Professor Ponisseril Somasundaran (better known to most of you as "Som"!) will be chair of the organising committee. The exact dates have yet to be fixed, but it will be sometime during the US summer vacation period (end of May to early September). The meeting will be organised jointly with the American Chemical Society, Colloid and Surface Science Division. It will have been 24 years since the last ICSCS meeting was held in North America (at Clarkson University in Potsdam in 1985). I believe that holding this meeting in the US will do much to strengthen the links that IACIS has with our North American colleagues. Hopefully, we will see more colleagues from that continent joining IACIS.

The reason that the decision took so long to announce was that we had four applications, and a vote by IACIS Council members was therefore held in order to decide. In the end it was a close-run decision, and I, on behalf of IACIS council, would like to again thank the other applicants for participating and all the hard work that they put into preparing their submissions. In particular, I would like mention the following three persons, who were the principle liaising persons for their respective organisations: Dr. Reinhard Miller from the Max Planck Institute for Surface and Colloid Science in Golm, Germany, Dr. Roque Hidalgo Alvarez from the University of Granada in Spain, and Dr. Patrick Hartley from the Royal Australian Chemical Institute, who wished to organise the meeting in Sydney. I received very pleasant letters from each of them, after I wrote informing them of the decision of IACIS Council.

As I also mentioned in my last Newsletter message, one of the intentions agreed at the last Council Meeting in Brazil was to try and strengthen the links IACIS has with other cross-national colloid and interface societies. It is important that we increase significantly the

number of members of IACIS worldwide. I am pleased to announce that the dual membership scheme with ECIS (The European Colloid and Interface Society) is now firmly in place. IACIS members are now able to join ECIS (and vice-versa) through either parent organisation, at a reduced combined fee. There are mutual website links to each organisation in place. Just to remind you of these:

Dimo Platikanov, Hans Lyklema and I were "guests" (in part representing IACIS Council) at the 17th ECIC meeting, held last July in Loughborough, UK, during which we discussed the future relationship between ECIS and ECIC (the long-standing, European Chemistry at Interfaces Conferences alternatively organised in Easter and Western European countries). It was decided to proceed with the next meeting in Budapest in September 2006, as a joint venture. Eventually I suspect (and hope!) that full merger will occur. Other ECIS news is that, as well as the Rhodia prize for mid-career, outstanding colloid and interface scientists, a new ECIS prize has been established for those who are longer-standing, major contributors to our field. This will be known as the "Overbeek Prize" and it was very appropriate that Professor Theo Overbeek himself should be the first recipient! Because of his fragile health, the award ceremony was carried out at Theo's own home by Hans Lyklema on behalf of ECIS last October. Another development is that ECIS will, from now on, take over responsibility for the European Colloid Student meetings, which have been held on a somewhat ad hoc basis previously. The two most recent of these meetings were organised in Bristol in 2003, and in Biezenmortel (Netherlands, organised from Wageningen) in 2005. It is planned that the next meeting will be in Sweden in 2007.

Both IACIS and ECIS are free-standing, non-profit-making societies, and, as such, it is possible to form a mutual membership link of the type described above. Obviously this is not so easy with more formal, national societies who represent their country's professional members in a given subject. However, as I mentioned before, we are still intending to build links with such societies (especially with the committees representing colloid interface science) and discussions are continuing. In particular, we have been in discussion so far with the Australian, Japanese, Chinese and US groups. I would be delighted to hear from other societies!

Please do let me know of any matters you would like to raise with myself and the other members of the Standing Committee of Council. See you (hopefully!) in China – if not before!

3.2 IACIS Standing Committee and Council

At the 2006 meeting in Beijing the Standing Committee and the Council will change, as happens every three years. Prof. Björn Lindman will be our new President, Prof. Brian Vincent will become Immediate Past President, and Prof. Dimo Platikanov will leave the Standing Committee.

A new President-elect will be installed after the present election round. After three successive European Presidents, we hope for a non-European President in 2009. As to the Council, six new members have to be elected, to serve for six years.

Enclosed with this Newsletter you will find a Call for Nominations.

Prof. Gerard Fleer has decided to step down as Honorary Secretary and Treasurer. He has served in this position since 1994. Previously, it became clear that Council and (the non-Wageningen part of) the Standing Committee have a strong preference for succession from within Wageningen. Dr. Mieke Kleijn from the Wageningen group has agreed to take over. Her appointment has already been approved by Council, and will be formalized in Beijing. In the next Newsletter, to appear in the Fall, she will introduce herself to the IACIS members.
