COST Action CM1101 Colloidal Aspects of Nanoscience for Innovative Processes and Materials

Started last year as the largest COST action of 31 EU-countries and as such one of the largest ever. This Action, lead by Piotr Warszynski from the Jerzy Haber Institute of Catalysis and Surface Chemistry in Cracow, Poland, organizes meetings, training schools, and allows researchers to visit partner institutes. It succeeds the Action D43 that was installed to allow for a better integration of European researchers in particular from the newly joined countries.
