Subject: **Transitional Arrangements considering TEM**

**Dear student,**

As you know, the university will start a new structure (project based modules of 15 EC) for all bachelor programs in September 2013. The regular courses will be discontinued in the following order:

- In 2013-2014 no B1-courses will be offered
- In 2014-2015 no B2-courses will be offered
- In 2015-2016 no B3-courses will be offered.

Extra examinations for these courses will only be offered one year after discontinuing the course. Hence, B1 examinations will only be offered in 2013-2014, B2 examinations only in 2014-2015 and B3 examinations only in 2015-2016. Students who do not pass these exams will have to participate in TEM-modules.

This means that finishing any B1 courses (propaedeutic phase) should have the highest priority in the coming year for you. It is very important that you keep these changes in mind while making a study planning (perhaps in cooperation with your study advisor). To help you to prepare for these changes we have made an overview of all transitional arrangements, which is attached to this email. These transitional arrangements will eventually be put in the education and exams regulations (Student Charter). The Student Charter for 2013-2014 will be published at the beginning of the next academic year by the dean. To ensure that you will be well prepared we will give you a general overview of these arrangements:

- For examinations two extra resits will be offered. However, this does not apply to sub-examinations.
- For practicals only one extra resit will be offered.
- The transitional arrangements are planned in such a way that the interference with the regular program is minimized. For instance deadlines will be planned just after a lecture-free week.
- In some occasions, examinations will be scheduled in another quartile than the initial course was offered.
