

Questionnaire

Goals

The goal of this instrument is slightly different compared with the other instruments. With this one we would like to provide you with a list of possible questions to ask during your evaluation session with students and lecturers. It is based upon questions we have asked throughout our projects and it is not a definitive list, but more of a prompt to help you find the questions that best fit your circumstances. We therefore do not recommend to just copy and paste it. It can also be used in other evaluation settings such as, for example, focus groups. It is not really scientific in nature, but still it encompasses the different aspects of blended learning.

You will notice that some are Likert scale while others are open-ended questions.

Possible questions for students' questionnaires

General

- I found the course challenging
- I had enough prior knowledge to successfully follow the course
- I would recommend this course to others
- What are the strong points of this course?
- If I had the option to change something in this course, I would change...
- Do you have any suggestion for improvement?
- The amount of study time I had to put in was doable

Organization

- The course is well organised as a whole (face-to-face and online)
- The online part of the course is well organised
- The face-to-face part of the course is well organised
- The study time required for the face-to-face and online part is reasonably balanced
- The online part prepared me for the face-to-face part
- The duration of the face-to-face part was sufficient


Learning

Assessment


- The quizzes motivated me to learn
