
What: Christmas event, including lunch, some drinks (you will receive three drink coupons), fun activities and, for those who were nice this year a nice Christmas gift!






P-NUTS BOARD INTEREST LUNCH



BENEFITS OF JOINING THE GROUP


- Ask for help with regulations, or any other related assistance;
