JOIN P-NUT'S PHD & PDENG DAY 2021



Summary

Event

The physical part will take place in the Waaier building, room Waaier 3 (**not in the Gallery building**, as indicated before). Registration opens at 12:00h and the keynote at 13:00h. A perfect time to get a coffee around 12:30h - with a sweet pastry.

Hybrid - online

The event will take place in a hybrid fashion, meaning physical and virtual. We will host the event via Zoom: (link can be obtained through registering for the event). Notice that we allow you to use the chat service (there is chat moderation).

Hybrid - physical

Admission to the physical event is given based on a **first-come, first-served** priority. You will get name tags that are valid during the whole event. If you decide to leave the event earlier, please inform one of the P-NUT board members, because then we could give access to other persons. Notice that we already reserved some seats for guests that play an active role during the day.

COVID-19 measures

We limit the maximum physical group size to 75. It is also required to show a **COVID-19 certificate (green pass)** upon entering the physical event.

Besides that, we urge you to comply with the basic measures as presented by the Dutch national government:

- Wear a mouth mask when you move from one room to another. If you are sitting down, the mouth mask may be removed.
- Wash your hands regularly, cough or sneeze into your elbow, do not shake hands.
- Perform a self-test regularly.
- Stay home if you have symptoms and get tested.
- Keep your distance.

• Keeping a distance of 1.5 metres is not compulsory, but is desirable if the situation allows.

Certificate of attendance

A certificate of attendance will be given to all participants who register and attend. It is calculated that the activities in the program equal 0.25 European Credits (ECs). The following requirements need to be fulfilled in order to obtain the certificate:

- 1. attendance at the online or physical sessions (and registered for the event);
- 2. fill in a survey from the Female Doctoral Candidate Initiative (the survey is anonymous, yet, we expect you to fill it in);
- 3. fill in a feedback form about the PhD & PDEng Day (submit before the 28th of November).

The **due date** for fulfilling these requirements is Sunday the 28th of November. YAs you may know, you can combine such certificates into a "package" worth 5EC and make some steps towards fulfilling your EC requirements.

Pitches



CHRISTMAS (DINNER) is coming !!!! Ho Ho Ho!!!!



Dutch stamppot

PHD AND PDENG WOMEN




BENEFITS OF JOINING THE GROUP
