BSA

RULES AT THE END OF THE FIRST YEAR:

1: ≥ 3 out of 4 modules

OR

2: ≥ 45 out of 60 EC **AND** have no more than one insufficient module study unit grade in each course of learning.

POSITIVE > CONTINUE INTO THE SECOND YEAR

NEGATIVE > QUIT THE PSYCHOLOGY PROGRAMME
