

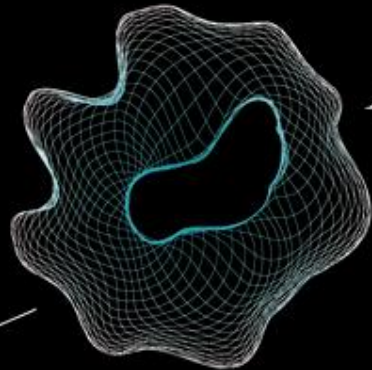

## Study programme year 2 PSY

  - Professional and psychological skills



## Study programme year 2 PSY compared to year 1?

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Less written (sub)tests per module, sometimes also less contact hours, and more independence and proactivity expected!

- With the elective modules you can focus on specialisations which have your interest
- Module Research methods and research project
  - Conducting research with a group
  - Writing an individual report
- Module Professional and psychological skills
  - Among other things psychological interviews/counselling, presenting skills and orientation workfield
  - A lot of assignments and putting your skills into practice

- Each module 15 ECTS
- First semester: 1 module per block/quartile

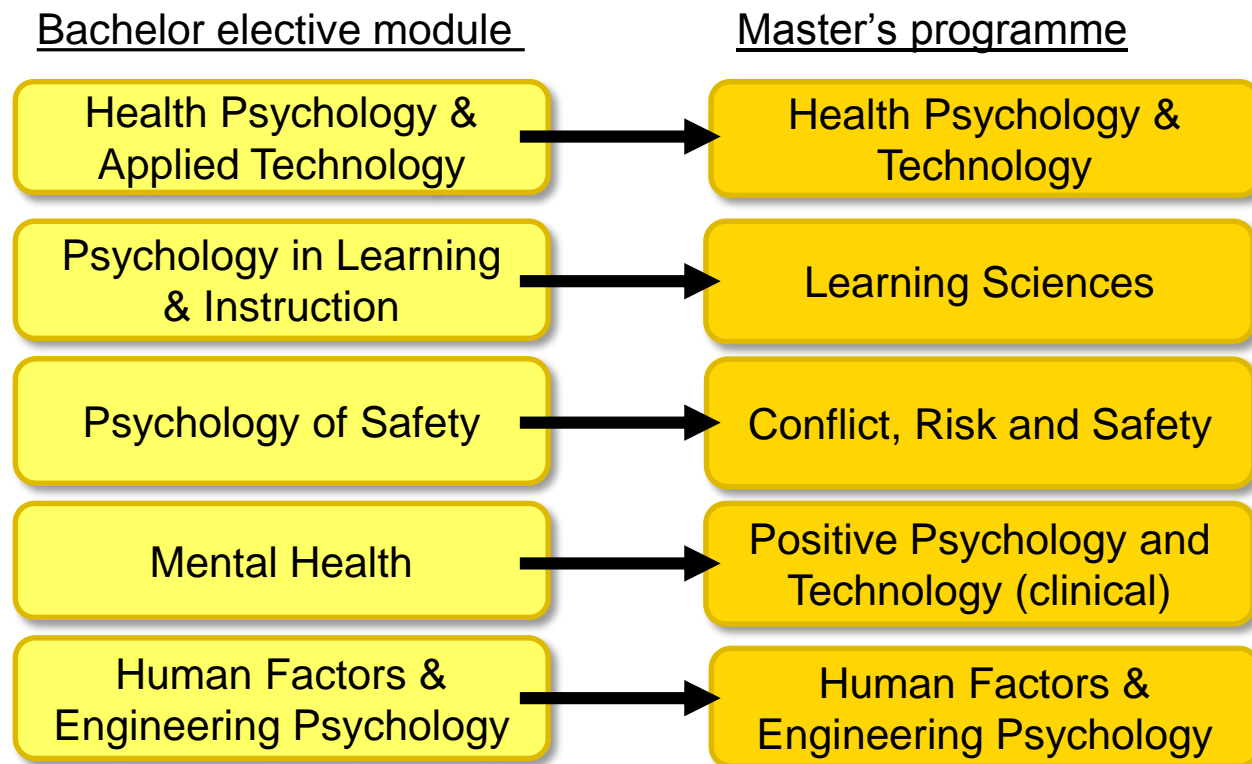

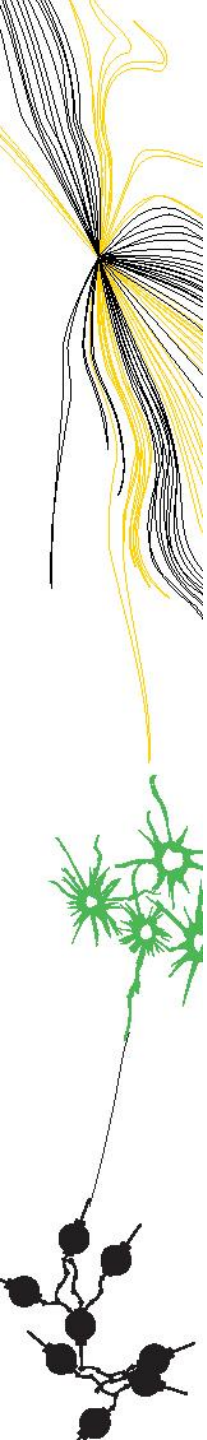
