36, 37	31 Aug – 11 Sept.	Appointment 1: Discuss the content of the research, the literature, the target group and possible measurement instruments.
38	14 – 18 Sept.	Hand in concept introduction
39	21 Sept – 25 Sept	Appointment 2: Discuss concept introduction, literature research and compose hypothesis or research question. Discuss ethical assessment. After appointment 2: register assignment in Mobility Online, download your application form, have it signed by your first supervisor and include your specialization. Check graduation web for the course code. Hand in the application form by mail to BOZ – don't upload it (boz-psy@utwente.nl) <u>at the latest</u> on the 12th of October.
40	28 Sept – 2 Oct.	Hand in your <u>Introduction</u> , your study design and planning and include your hypothesis/research question.

For this appointment your first supervisor may invite your second supervisor to this meeting as well, if needed. Check if ethical approval has been obtained before the start of the data collection.

42	From the 12 th of October	Start data collection (if you have obtained approval of the Ethics Committee)

Presentation bachelor's thesis. Your supervisor will inform BOZ about the grade for the bachelor's thesis and will provide them with the assessment forms. Send your bachelor's thesis (online in Word and PDF) to BOZ and upload your thesis to the library of the University.

4	18 – 22 Jan.	Appointment 8: Discuss approach for the re-sit based on the feedback received at the green-light appointment. The green light version is the last draft on which you will receive feedback.
7	8 Feb.	Hand in <u>the re-sit of the green light version of the bachelor's thesis</u> , according to the agreements made with your supervisor. Green light version will be assessed by your supervisor and a second examiner.
8	15 Feb. at the latest	Appointment 9: Green light appointment: permission/no permission to present the bachelor's thesis. Supervisor informs BOZ about the decision.
8/9	Discuss date with supervisor (Deadline is the day of your presentation at the latest)	Hand in the final version of your bachelor's thesis with your supervisor and examiner, according to the agreements that are made with your supervisor.
