

## Master's programme Psychology 2021-2022

The Master's programme in Psychology (60EC, 1 year) offers five specializations in the field of psychology:

- Human Factors & Engineering Psychology
- Conflict, Risk & Safety
- Learning Sciences
- Health Psychology & Technology
- Positive Clinical Psychology & Technology

The language of communication, instruction and examination in the MSc programme Psychology is English. This means that in all tracks/specializations:

- Study materials are in English.
- Classes (lectures, seminars, workshops, practicals, and others) are taught in English\*.
- Exams and assignments are composed in English and students have to complete all exams and assignments in English\*/\*\*.
- Presentations (including the master's thesis presentation) have to be prepared in English.

\* In the master's specialisation Positive Clinical Psychology & Technology Dutch (speaking) students have the possibility to practise, get feedback on, and do assignments in (counselling) skills in Dutch during some practical/clinical courses.

\*\* For the internship part of the master's programme deviation of this rule is allowed in case (writing) the internship in English is impossible due to the nature of the (Dutch) internship organization. It is then allowed to compose the internship product and/or report in Dutch.

**Students can start the master(tracks) in September or February. The programme for student who enrol in February (2022) can be found in this document.**
