



## Improved presentation on participant portal

- **presentation of calls on PP identical** to presentation in WP documents (no sub-/technical calls)
- direct **link** to relevant **WP part document** (pdf)
- direct **link** to relevant **Horizon 2020 web page**
- header of call & topic pages displays **taxonomy** of pillar and relevant WP part of call/topic
- **call budget division** directly available (per year and per group of topics; or per topic; or per topic and type of action combination)
- increased visibility of **type of action**
- all information **visible on one page** instead of tabs
- immediate access to the **submission system** ('button')

## General Annex H - Evaluation

- No major change – some fine-tuning, based on experience
  - re Lessons-learned : *"...review the evaluation process in response to the feedback received"*
- Adjustments to the wording of the "aspects to be taken into account", under each criterion:
  - Excellence – refer to "inter-disciplinarity" and cross-sector/stakeholder involvement as appropriate (re H2020 Art.14)
  - Impact – streamlined wording; emphasising more the impact statement in the work-programme topics
  - Implementation – each partner should have important role, and resources to match; clarifying that over-inflated work-packages penalised
- Dynamic threshold for first stage passing proposals
