Dear Members,

The Program Committee of Systems and Control (S&C) is of the opinion that the order of the Internship (201400462) and Master's Graduation Project (201100179) should not be reversed, i.e., the Graduation Project should follow the Internship. In other words, we confirm the use of the word "final" in the course description as can be read in the Osiris course catalogue: *"The graduation project is the final proof of the ability of the student to independently handle more complex problems within the area of Systems & Control, ..."*

The main reason for this opinion is that doing an internship (20 EC) prior to the graduation project (40 EC) offers the student a unique opportunity to develop and get feedback on learning goals that are needed for a successful completion of the graduation project. This applies e.g., to defining his/her own research goals, planning the work for an extensive project, applying knowledge and skills from the S&C course program, interacting with a (research) team and presenting the outcome of the work.
