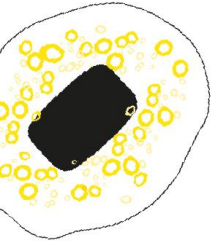

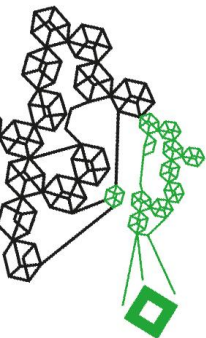
Advice regarding the EEMCS Master's and Systems & Control (S&C) Education and Examination Regulations (EER) by the Systems & Control (S&C) Program Committee (PC)

Dear Members of the EEMCS Faculty Council and EEMCS Director of Education,

In their meeting of April 12, 2021 the Systems & Control Program Committee has concluded towards a positive advice regarding the proposed EEMCS Master's EER (part A) and Systems & Control EER (Part B) for academic year 2021-2022. However, we would like to add the following remarks:

### Part A - EEMCS Master's EER

- Two typographical errors:
  - Article A1.1.10: "off" should be "of".
  - Article A4.7.4: "student" is missing in "... the participates, ...".
- Article A5.3: In the criteria for "*Cum laude*" some ambiguity will arise about the starting date in cases where a student combines BSc and MSc programs.
  - Does this article refer to the start date of the MSc program or the date of the BSc degree?
  - If the start date of the MSc program is considered, this may be unfair when a student starts the MSc program only "part-time" as long as the BSc program still has to be finished.
  - In such cases the Examination Board can still decide to grant the judicium *Cum Laude* according to article A5.3.3.
  - The Program Committee recommends to make a fair calculation of the time actually spend for the MSc program in case the above mentioned condition applies.

## Part B - Programme specific section Systems & Control Master's programme EER

- Article B5.4: In the planning for the graduation project no minimum term is mentioned for the submission of the final report to the graduation committee.
  - The Program Committee recommends to mention a minimum term for the final report in a future EER. It can either be included as some specific term-limit or to explicitly leave this at the discretion of the graduation committee.
