



Goodbye DataMonitor, Welcome DataCite

The Pure upgrade to version 5.33 (19-06-2025) includes the sunsetting of the Pure-DataMonitor integration. As from that moment, the Pure-DataCite integration will be used to search and retrieve datasets, stored in multiple dataset-repositories.

DataCite is automatically enabled in the automated search settings in your profile
