1. Opening and Determining Agenda

The meeting opens at 10:46. Langerak welcomes Lars Kruitwagen, new student member. As currently the only student member, Lars is also invited to become vice-chair of the PC.

2. Minute maker for PC

We used to have a student minute maker, but with recent cuts this will end. Langerak proposes to take turns for minute making for the time being (and have leaner minutes), and in case re-discuss this with the next PC Chair. The PC agrees with this.

3. New members

There are two remaining members, Sperotto and Alachiotis. Currently there are two open positions for staff members, and three for student members.

For the staff members, we are in the process of finding the last member of the selection committee (Geert Heijenk will join as member of the Faculty Council). The next step will be to set up interviews.

Kruitwagen will take action for finding student members.

4. Announcement PD

- The new study year started. After the matching hearing we kept 73% of the students who applied. The kick-in week went well.
- New students: slightly more than 300 officially, the effective number is expected to stabilize after a few weeks.
- Currently designing the mandatory matching for next year, such that all will work well when it is time.
- 19th October: graduation ceremony, for the first time in two slots due to the number of students.
- EEMCS Research and Networking day: this time there was quite some talks also

about education

- Changes at the Faculty level: Mirije van Dijk is the new operational director, Boudewijn Haverkort will be the new Dean
- October 10: Meet the CS department
- Financial situation: TCS was responsible for 1/5 of all TA at the UT. We will now have to cut 1/3 of the costs this year and 50% next year. Zaytsev will coordinate a join effort to allocate TAs within TCS.
- We have this year 93 new master students, 17 pre-master and 18 transfer students.
- We are still looking into separating Data Science as a specialization and we are looking into opening a new specialization on Sustainable Computing
- There is a complaint from PC of EMSYS about one of the courses we have shared in our master, but this is being handled.
- The UT is trying to introduce mandatory admission fees for students with a diploma issued from not-Dutch organization. This will have a large impact on students especially from poor countries. CS has complained about this but so far the decision has not been changed.

7. Al Policy

There seems to be a need for a shared AI policy, as the UT-wide one was not detailed enough for TCS.

Kruitwagen: the policy title is about AI, but it seems to target GAI. This might not make very clear in which cases a student needs to write down that a tool has been used. Zaytsev points out that this should be chosen based on the goal/methodology of the educational activity.

The PC gives positive advice.

Langerak proposes to postpone this to when we will be less understaffed.
