Dear Programme Director

The OLC-IDE has received the proposal on how to change the name of the BSc programme "Industrial Design" to "Industrial Design Engineering". The change itself is supported by the OLC-IDE, yet this advice concerns the approach to effectuate this change. Two options were presented to the OLC-IDE:

1. The registration in the CROHO.
2. Permission of the Board of the University

The OLC-IDE has read the explanation as given by the Programme Director in the document "Change of name ID – IDE.docx" and heard his further explanation during OLC-IDE meeting 129, held Monday June 4<sup>th</sup> 2018 and has arrived at an advice, in terms of a preference for either the first or the second option.

The Programme Committee (OLC), has seen the two options to change the name, has discussed this during the OLC-meeting at 04.06.2018. and has decided, after a vote with a unanimous outcome, to advice to proceed with option 2.
