Nominations University Council

You can put yourself forward as a candidate for the University Council (URaad) elections on Wednesday 10 April 2019.

You can download a nomination form via the URaad website in advance or collect one from the Central Polling Station (Spiegel, room 409).

To run as a candidate, you have to submit a list of candidates with a minimum of one candidate (and a maximum of fifteen candidates); signatures of five voters (none of which are candidates themselves).

You can submit your own list, but you can also join an existing party.

The form must be handed in at Spiegel 409 before 17:00 hours (on Wednesday 10 April 2019).
