

Evaluation report: Advanced Programming in Engineering – 2012/2013

The evaluation committee has evaluated the course Advanced Programming in Engineering by sending an online questionnaire to 34 students. 4 students filled in the questionnaire, which gives a response of 12%. Because of the low response for this course, this report will only consist of a summary of the reactions.

Respondents indicate that there were too many assignments for the amount of European Credits (0,5 EC) earned. One respondent suggests handing out a schedule at the beginning of the course, as an examination break between two blocks of lectures made it unclear when the new lecture hours were planned. Another remark is about the requirements for the exam. It was unclear what the weight of each subject was, since not all assignments were mandatory. Apart from these comments, the course scores satisfactory and it must be noted that it scores a consistent ten for the availability of the teacher.

These are the main conclusions of the evaluation. The interpretation is based on the remarks of the respondents. For an overview of the results, see the graph at the end of this report.
