1. Minutes EB-meeting d.d. 23-11-2020 (agenda-item 11)

The Executive Board decides to approve the minutes of the EB-meeting d.d. 23-11-2020.

2. Mandated decisions d.d. 30-11-2020 (agenda-item 12)

The Executive Board decides to adopt the confidential mandated decisions d.d. 30-11-2020. These are:

6. MoMi annual report 2019-2020 (agenda-item 16)

The Executive Board

- takes note of the annual report 2019-2020
- requests the Vice Deans Education to ensure that the existing recommendation mentioned under 2.3 will be executed within the faculties and to consider appropriate measures in addressing the recommendations, taken into account the agreements mentioned in 2.3 that were made to start addressing this recommendation
- asks S&P to follow up on the issue (the significant group that is studying with considerable delay) and formulate specific recommendations in close collaboration with the SWIP project group, platform study counselling and PIA, because further research is recommended to see whether this signal regarding study progress reflects a more structural and systemic issue and if so what are the root causes. This delay may contribute to financial difficulties (and distress) of students when they have expected to need resources only for the nominal study duration. A study plan with a clear and realistic perspective on funding is needed. The CPO has advised to have clear discussions with students about this.
