

Bachelor programme European Studies Double Diploma 2014-2015

The third year (60 EC) of the Double Diploma Programme European Studies (old style)

This programme is intended for the old style double diploma students who did their first two years at the University of Muenster and do their third year in **2014-2015** at the University of Twente.

The only option is to follow a standard study programme (see appendix 1) with a minor of 20 EC: students can choose Niederlande-Deutschland Studien (at Muenster), Innovation & Entrepreneurship, History, International Management & Exploration (the 20 EC version) or Sustainable Development (the 20 EC version). This standard programme includes:

- Two obligatory courses in quartile 1 (Project 4: Regional innovation in Europe) and in quartile 2 (Methodology and research design). Each course is 5 EC, so a total of 10 EC.
- A minor of 20 EC (10 EC in quartile 1 and 10 EC in quartile 2).
- The module European Studies (2.2A) of the EPA-programme (15 EC in quartile 3) called the EU after the Financial-Economic Crisis.
- The bachelor thesis (15 EC in quartile 4).

Internship: An internship is not an official part of the programme. If you want to do an 'internship' we recommend you to do this in the form of an external bachelor assignment in the fourth quartile.

Other points to notice:

- **IMPORTANT:** The bachelor thesis must be supervised by lecturers from both universities: one from Twente and one from Muenster. Both are responsible as first supervisors for their respective universities. For administrative reasons on the SMS-form (see the Blackboard-site) the supervisor from Twente must always be filled in as your first supervisor.
- You have to enrol for the minors through OSIRIS (but students from Muenster can enrol in another way). For more information on the minors also check the website of the minors:

Transitory arrangements

For students of the old style double diploma programme who started their third year in Twente in the academic year **2013-2014** re-exams are offered for the three obligatory courses that are not offered anymore (Methodology and research design is still offered). Students are strongly advised to do the exams and-the re-exams in the academic years in which they are still offered. For students that still miss courses afterwards, other – preferably tailor-made - solutions will be sought

For one course a written re-exam will be scheduled in the Exam Roster of 2014-2015:

- European Legal Governance (194125040)

For the other two courses are practical assignments. Students have to contact the teacher of the course themselves before the start of the quarter the course was originally scheduled. The courses are:

- European Economic Governance (194103020)
- Governance of European Social Policies (194107140)

Students of the old style double diploma programme who will start their third year in Twente in the academic year **2015-2016** will do a an individual programme. Because the courses in the first semester will not be offered anymore they will be replaced by two 15 EC-modules of the new EPA programme:

- Public Management (201400091) in the first quarter;
- Public Governance in Europe (201400093) in the second quarter.

In the third quarter they do the European Studies (2.2A) module, in the fourth the bachelor thesis.
