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## QUALITY ASSURANCE

## FRAUD

Please make sure that you are aware of the rules regarding fraud and the consequences of fraud.

It is for example not allowed:

- to use material which is not permitted by the examiner;
- to cheat during the test (e.g. by the use of unauthorized material) or to commit forgery,
- **to plagiarize.**

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Consequences can be:

- to not be allowed to take one or more tests, examinations or final examinations for a certain period of time (determined by the Board of Examination) for a maximum of one year;
- **or to permanently be expelled.**

The entire rules regarding fraud can be found on the website in the Rules of the Board of Examiners, article 6.
